## SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY SHERIFF-CORONER DEPARTMENT

This is a full-time permanent position with a salary range of \$190,424 – \$249,849 per annum. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience. Increased compensation is available for certain additional certifications. San Bernardino County offers an attractive benefits package which includes: sick leave, vacation leave, annual leave, holiday leave, conference leave, medical and dental coverage, vision care insurance, life insurance, short term disability, expense reimbursement, retirement plan, salary savings plan, conference allowance, publication allowance, professional dues & membership allowance, and recruitment relocation assistance.

The forensic pathologist duties and responsibilities include: conducting complete and timely postmortem autopsy examinations, providing the determination of the cause and manner of death, timely preparing of pathology reports, and providing testimony.

Qualified candidates must possess a valid Physician's and Surgeon's License issued by the State of California, possess certification in Surgical Pathology by the American Board of Pathology, be in, or have completed, a fellowship in Forensic Pathology, and be eligible for certification in Forensic Pathology by the time of commencing work here.

San Bernardino County has a population of over two million and is located east of Los Angeles. It borders Nevada and Arizona and is the largest county in the contiguous United States. In 2016, the Coroner Division, which currently includes four full time forensic pathologists and one part time forensic pathologist, performed approximately 1600 forensic autopsies.

Professional sporting venues and entertainment opportunities in San Diego, Los Angeles and Las Vegas are generally within a short drive of the county seat, the city of San Bernardino. Several Southern California beaches are within an hour's drive. Local mountains and deserts provide a variety of recreational locations for rock climbing, hiking, skiing, snowboarding, and various other outdoor activities.
