### **Supervising Medical Examiner Investigator**

Supervising Medical Examiner Investigators supervise the activities of the Investigation Division of the Medical Examiner's Department and provide direction and oversight to the most complex cases. Incumbents supervise, plan, and direct the activities of medical examiner investigators. This position will provide daily supervision to 20 investigators and their administrative support staff. Positions in this class are not sworn peace officers. This is the first line supervisory level of the series and positions are only allocated to the Medical Examiner's Department.

The ideal candidate will be a knowledgeable investigator with experience that includes leadership, the ability to communicate effectively with executive management team, as well as the ability to solve problems and interact with the media.

#### **Education and/or Experience:**

Education, training, and/or experience that demonstrate possession of the knowledge, skills and abilities listed above. Required education and experience:

- 1. Four (4) years of experience conducting medico-legal investigations, three (3) years of which must be equivalent to the Medical Examiner Investigator III with the County of San Diego, OR
- 2. Five (5) years of experience conducting medico-legal investigations, four (4) years of which must be equivalent to the Medical Examiner Investigator II or higher with the County of San Diego, OR
- 3. Five (5) years of experience in a Coroner's or Medical Examiner's office performing progressively responsible death investigations, one (1) year of which included team leadership/supervisory responsibilities.

A valid California Class C driver's license, which must be maintained throughout employment in this class, is required at time of appointment, or the ability to arrange necessary and timely transportation for field travel. Employees in this class may be

required to use their own vehicle.

#### **Evaluation:**

Qualified candidates will be placed on a **twelve (12) month** employment list. Please ensure all information is complete and accurate, as the responses you provide on the supplemental application questionnaire will be reviewed using an automated evaluation system. If you are successful in the initial screening process, your application will be reviewed individually to confirm that the information you provided is accurate and qualifying.
