 or university with course work in public administration,
 administration of justice, or related field and experience in
 a coroner/public administrator environment or a public
 agency working with death investigations equivalent to six
 (6) years, two of which must have been in a supervisory
 capacity. OR
- Ten (10) years of experience working in a coroner/public administrator environment or a public agency working with death investigations, three (3) of which must have been in a supervisory capacity AND valid registration as a certified American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigator.
