



## Deputy Medical Examiner

The Waukesha County Medical Examiner's Office is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Deputy Medical Examiner.

### Location:

Waukesha County is located in the Southeast corner of Wisconsin, next to the Milwaukee Metropolitan area, two hours northwest of Chicago, 30 minutes from downtown Milwaukee and approximately one hour from Madison. The County population is 390,000. Waukesha County is one of the fastest growing counties in Wisconsin.

### Work Duties & Environment:

This position would be responsible for investigating deaths in accordance with Wisconsin State Statutes, including evaluating death scenes, examining and preserving evidence, investigating the circumstances of death by obtaining personal data and medical history through records and interviews; and establishes initial assessment of cause and manner of death as natural, suicidal, accidental, or homicidal. This office serves as a regional medical examiner center for three suburban counties.

### Minimum Qualifications:

1. Graduation from a recognized college or university with a bachelor's degree in such areas as biological or medical science, anatomy, physical therapy, physical anthropology, medical technology, nursing, or a closely related field.  
OR
2. Four (4) years of work experience in medico-legal death investigation, medical or biological sciences, police sciences, as a pathology or autopsy assistant; or a closely related area preferable in a medical examiner's or coroner's office.

Preferred candidates will have previous work experience with human physical anthropology.

### Salary & Benefits:
