

Morgue Technician

The Franklin County Coroner's Office is accepting applications for Morgue Technician. Successful applicants will be expected to: prepare for autopsy and assist pathologist during autopsies by taking photographs and X-rays; eviscerate body; obtain, secure and deliver toxicology specimens; organize, archive, send and receive histology samples, slides and block; ensure proper identification of human remains; ensure safe and effective working environment by maintaining clean work areas, equipment and instruments; and accept and release bodies.

Qualifications: The preferred applicant will have a Bachelor's degree in related health care or forensic field and one (1) year experience in autopsy skills; or an equivalent combination of education and experience, however job experience alone will be considered. Must secure and maintain a favorable background investigation from Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation and Identification and the Franklin County Sheriff's Office.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Must have knowledge of Ohio Revised Code 313 and related sections; knowledge of evidence collection and transfer techniques; knowledge of human anatomy; knowledge of medical terminology; and knowledge of health and safety standards and practices. Must be able to effectively respond to inquiries, conflicts and public relations issues; communicate effectively, both verbally and in writing; maintain effective working relationships with co-workers, County employees, government agencies, outside organizations, and the general public. Must possess the ability to operate a personal computer, facsimile, copier, and digital camera.
